## 2006 Rules for Eventing – Exemptions to Qualifications

According to Article 506.6 for the 2006 Rules for Eventing, the FEI with the agreement of the OC of a CCIO/CCI/CIC and the NF of the host country, may under exceptional circumstances, waive the qualification standards of a horse but only at the specific written request of the rider's NF.

Please note that your National Federation is ultimately responsible for all such exemptions to horses.

Further to the decision of the Eventing Committee, it has been decided that exemptions only be given in very exceptional circumstances and according to the following procedure:

1. Exemptions will only be granted to horses, **riders must be qualified.**
2. Reason of request must be stated by the NF and exemptions will only be granted for Championship selection purposes and on events that allow qualification for the level of the specific Championship in the same year in which the championship will be held.
3. Reason for exemptions: lack of events in region further to cancellations etc. NF will be requested to provide details on reasons.
4. **Requests have to be submitted to the FEI at least 10 days before the beginning of the event to be processed. Late requests will not be accepted.**
5. Request must be accompanied by a detailed summary of both the rider and horse's performance record, including all the horse's competitions at national and international CICs and CCIs during the current and previous year.
6. NFs must be informed that grant of exemptions is a system for exceptional circumstances and not to be used as a parallel qualifying system.
7. The Organising Committee of the event in question must agree.

The exemption procedure will be reviewed each year by the Eventing Committee
